

NORTH GEORGIA TECHNICAL COLLEGE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR BRYANT RESIDENCE HALL

Is there a curfew for Bryant Residence Hall visitors? All outside visitors have to be out of the Bryant Residence Hall each evening by 10:30 pm, Sunday-Wednesday and midnight on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. No one under the age of sixteen will be allowed to visit unless they have received prior permission from the Director of Student Affairs. Residents of Bryant Hall can visit in other students' rooms as long as the door is partially open.

What size are the dorm rooms? Each room is approximately 15' X 15'.

May we have a refrigerator in our room? Yes, the compact size refrigerator works great for the dorm rooms.

Is there a kitchen in Bryant Resident Hall? There is a kitchen in Bryant Residence Hall with a full size stove, refrigerator, microwave, toaster, snack machine and soft drink machine for the students' use. However, the student must provide all utensils for cooking. (pans, spatulas, etc.)

What size are the beds? The beds are twin/long size.

What furniture is furnished in each dorm room? In some rooms, there is a chest of drawers. Two twin beds will remain in each room. No sofas or love seats or other heavy furniture is allowed.

Am I responsible for cleaning my own room? Each student is responsible for cleaning their own room. Periodically, there are room checks for cleanliness.

Are there laundry facilities in Bryant Residence Hall? There are washers and dryers on the first floor of Bryant Residence Hall. Each load requires 4 quarters.

What appliances should I leave at home? Do not bring microwaves, toasters, toaster ovens or coffee makers.

Is cable T.V. provided? Each room has access to cable TV.

Are pets allowed? No.

Is phone service provided? Students are responsible for setting this up through the local telephone service provider.

May I bring a car to campus? Yes. But you are responsible for obtaining a parking permit and you must follow Campus Parking Regulations. Parking Citations are issued to violators.

May I bring a bicycle to campus? Yes, there is a bicycle rack provided in the Bryant Residence Hall yard. Each student is responsible for his own bike and may wish to have a chain lock for safety precautions. Bicycles or similar recreational vehicles are not allowed in the Bryant Residence Hall.

Are there other items I can bring to campus? Yes, here is a list of suggested and optional items for Bryant Hall Residents:

SUGGESTED & OPTIONAL ITEMS FOR BRYANT HALL RESIDENTS

- Pillows, sheets and other bedding (twin size, long)
- Toiletries (carrying case & flip-flops for shower)
- Cleaning and laundry supplies
- TV/VCR/DVD/Radio
- Telephone (Service is student's responsibility)
- Towels and washcloths
- Compact Refrigerator
- Computer
- Alarm Clock
- Fan (no ceiling fans) or Air conditioner (apprx. 5000-5200 btu)
- Under bed storage containers

Are there any items I should not bring to campus or that or not allowed? Yes, here is a list of prohibited items:

DO NOT BRING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Microwave ovens
- Toaster/toaster oven
- Space heaters
- Incense
- Firearms
- Coffee makers
- Hotplates
- Candles
- Alcoholic Beverages
- Pets
- Water filled furniture
- Loveseat, recliner, or sofa or any other furniture not approved by Student Affairs

Tobacco Violation Citations will be given and a fine applied to the student's account. Use of any type of tobacco product is strictly prohibited.

Are computer labs available? No, there is not a computer lab in Bryant Residence Hall. However, the campus library has computers available for use by all students.

Is Bryant Residence Hall wired for computers? Yes, Bryant Residence Hall is wireless.
